



QUALITY POLICY

Our project began in 1963 with the objective of creating a company operating in the precision machining sector. OLM immediately focused on the aerospace industry, obtaining aerospace qualification certification for the machining of aircraft structures and components.

After achieving this first objective, in 1989 we expanded our market by specializing in the machining of aluminum and steel connecting rods, becoming a reliable partner for strategic components in the compressor and air treatment equipment sector.

The company's exponential growth enabled significant investments, leading to a major organizational restructuring and continuous innovation to keep pace with technological development. This approach also gave rise to new collaborations with manufacturers of railway coaches and transportation equipment.

At the beginning of the new millennium, we successfully undertook a new challenge: the complete manufacture and assembly of industrial compressor units, including testing and high-pressure operational trials. To support this activity, we relocated our facilities to obtain more space and meet all production requirements.

In 2018, OLM returned to Volpiano. This new move led us to a larger facility, not only to accommodate additional machinery but, above all, to respond to the increasing and more frequent demands of our customers. This has enabled us to become increasingly involved in the production and high-pressure testing of assembled compressor units, effectively supporting international partnerships with both European and non-European companies with whom we have established long-standing relationships.

6. **Development and expansion of the new operating facility.**
7. **Implementation of additional machinery to achieve complete job order management.**
